

# Call for Exhibition Committee Members

Interested in making a difference to the Cape Breton arts community? Have you ever considered volunteering on a committee with the Cape Breton Centre for Craft and Design?

Cape Breton Centre for Craft and Design is seeking individuals interested in serving on its exhibition committee.

This committee plans, develops and facilitates exhibition activities that engage the public, spark dialogue, and encourage collaboration. Committee members are volunteers with professional experience in their fields and are selected through application.

Committee members must enjoy work in and interacting with people and have a positive attitude. Committee members receive no remuneration for their work but may be reimbursed for authorized expenditures made on behalf of the Cape Breton Centre for Craft and Design.

Maximum term: 3 years

## Roles and Responsibilities of Committee Members

Committee members:

- Attend regular committee meetings at least three times per year
- Maintain an awareness of the arts community and the changing artistic practices, trends and issues within the discipline
- Advise on related matters, including the development of new opportunities/needs in the community
- Promote exhibitions online (Facebook, Twitter, etc.)
- Support and promotion the Cape Breton Centre for Craft and Design

## Criteria for Committee Membership

Committee members must:

- Be a member of the Cape Breton Centre for Craft and Design
- Be knowledgeable and experienced in their respective discipline, either as a professional or volunteer
- Have no real or perceived bias respecting any special interest group while serving as Committee members
- Consider the best interests of the entire Cape Breton arts community

While the number of formal meetings may not be more than three each year, committee members will need to dedicate time to review programming, develop calls and review submissions with Cape Breton Centre for Craft and Design staff and other committee members.
